During this month the classes will be reading lots of Dr. Seuss books.

Reading is so important, when you read to your child it helps develop their language and listening skills. When children look at a book with an adult, they increase their capacity for "Joint attention," noticing what others see and following their gaze. This encourages the development of executive function, an array of skills that includes the ability to remember details and to pay attention. Executive function is crucial when learning new things. By contrast fast-paced TV shows have been shown to impair executive function in young children. Having conversations with your child helps with their language development, and critical thinking skills. Readers are leaders!

We are looking forward to our Super Dads night on March 7th. We have some fun experiments planned. There is a sign-up sheet posted outside your child's classroom. Please sign up, so we can make sure we have enough ice cream for everyone. There will be a rotation schedule posted. Please be on time, we will start promptly at 6:30. Classes will spend 20 minutes in each rotation. Your child may bring one special adult with them to share this fun evening. We have three very special super scientists this year!
