November 7th - Happy Hour at Lost Boy Cider from 6-9pm. Meet some fellow parents and enjoy local hard cider and food trucks!

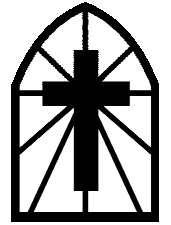
