We would like to thank Dr. Hughes and Dr. Hughes for coming to our school and sharing dental facts and magic tricks with all the children! It was good to hear them laugh. The kids each received a cup with toothpaste and a toothbrush. Hopefully they shared some of the tricks they saw!

During the month of March we will be reading lots of Dr. Seuss books. Kids love books! Reading every day is an exercise for the mind. When you read to your child at home you are helping them to increase their vocabulary, creativity, and critical thinking skills. Listening to stories helps them to improve focus and concentration. Reading to your child also creates a special bond between you both. I enjoyed sharing a Dr. Seuss book in each of the classes. Your children are great listeners!

In March the classes will be doing lots of hands-on measurement math activities. Students will have fun measuring items in their classroom using a non-standard measurement. Children can use counters or items such as popsicle sticks or paperclips. It is important to have children use manipulatives to count and answer math questions. Sorting objects using different criteria is a great activity to do at school and at home. Children can sort coins, buttons or cereal. Lucky Charms and Fruit Loops are great cereals for kids to sort and count. Try asking questions using the terms "more than" or "less than."

In chapel we will talk about the trinity, Palm Sunday, and Easter. The children are doing a great job learning the sign language for each fruit of the spirit. This month we are learning about faithfulness. The children do a wonderful job acting out bible stories, singing, listening and praying. I hope they share some of our songs at home. We appreciate all your help and support! Our teachers have worked hard this year to make sure your children are learning and having fun! We are all looking forward to spring and being able to spend more time outdoors.
