#### News from the Director

Spring is here! There is new life all around us. Young children are curious, inclined to explore, and eager to learn about the world around them. They have learned that God made them and He has a purpose for their life. They also learned that God created the world. Nature has a way of teaching us about God. Our caterpillars will be arriving soon. Each class will be able to watch and observe the changes and the transformation of caterpillars to butterflies. The children will also be studying insects, plants, flowers and life cycles this month.

This time of year you can observe so many things changing outside. Children learn science through trial and error. They need time to experiment, try things out and think through the process. Try using items you have at home to do experiments and let them explore. Try putting a piece of celery in water with food coloring. Have your child predict what will happen. Children can see how the colored water travels up the stalk, just like a plant draws up water from its roots. Have your child determine what objects will sink and which ones will float. Ask them questions and answer their questions. This is a great way to develop their oral language skills and critical thinking skills. Being able to communicate, analyze and reason are lifetime skills they will need in the future.

It has been wonderful to see the growth of your children during the school year! We are looking forward to doing more activities outdoors as the weather gets nicer. Please apply sunscreen and bug spray before coming to school if you think your child needs it. Thank you again for partnering with us to help your children become life-long learners!
