Here's a summary of the types of volunteers we will need to help make this event a success! This is a huge event for only a few people to organize so having extra hands for these items will make a big difference. Please prayerfully consider ways that you can volunteer your time and talents to make this event a success!

- Raffle: Determine a large prize, print/cut tickets and distribute to families
- **Silent Auction Donations:** distribute letters in the community and collect donations (Everyone can help!)
