Programming and Teaching Team

Our program is delivered with purpose and provides challenge and support for successful learning as our teachers listen, observe, and interpret children's behavior. Our teaching team coordinates school-wide thematic lessons, and each teacher brings their own creativity and unique experiences to the classroom. We plan for enriching, fun filled, explorative days. This also includes sharing biblical truths and Christian values through classroom practices in prayer, bible stories, scripture reference and weekly chapel. All children have recess/gross motor development every day, rain or shine.



We use a combination of teaching strategies to encourage a love for learning while instilling a foundation for academic success. Our curriculum incorporates a fun, hands-on learning approach to letter and number recognition while building early reading and writing skills. We incorporate Handwriting and Math Without Tears, along with science and critical thinking skills.
